# MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

The Creative Producer will manage a range of Helix Arts' participatory arts projects/productions and have lead responsibility for planning the projects and delivering them to meet agreed targets. This will involve:

- Supporting Helix Arts' senior management team to develop new projects, fundraising strategies and new business opportunities.
- Leading our work with our partners to plan each project's strategy, schedule of activities and budget.
- Lead on Helix Arts' programme, developing partnerships and facilitating sessions with community volunteers.
- Working with project teams to implement the plans agreed with partners from inception to completion.
- Ensuring that projects are delivered within agreed budgets and project milestones.
- Coordinating the recruitment and selection of artists, producers and other arts organisations involved in our projects.
- Overseeing the contracting of artists and other arts organisations involved with our projects.
- Working with partner organisations to plan induction sessions for creative practitioners, support staff and volunteers.
- Providing general support and advice to artists and other arts and community organisations involved in our projects.
- Ensuring relevant information is disseminated to partners accurately and in a timely manner.
- Coordinating marketing and publicity for our projects.
- Coordinating production and presentation of creative outputs (such as workshops, exhibitions, film screenings, publication launches, etc.).
- Managing the monitoring and evaluation of projects.
- Developing exit and legacy strategies and contributing to the planning of future projects.

In addition, the Creative Producer will be expected to:

- Work with the senior management team to develop and implement Helix Arts' policies and procedures.
- Follow Helix Arts' policies and procedures, including health and safety, safeguarding of children and vulnerable groups, and equal opportunities.
